Chao-Ying Rao (Femme Castratrice) is an East Asian visual artist based in Glasgow who primarily works with performance, photography, and moving image. Her practice involves negotiating the complexities around objectification and narcissism, often using humour to disarm and charm the viewer. Rao is interested in the absurdity of desire, excessive consumption, racial and bodily fetishisation, and abject femininity. Working with Kristeva's theory of abjection and Creed's monstrous feminine, her work plays with that very fine line between attraction and repulsion.
